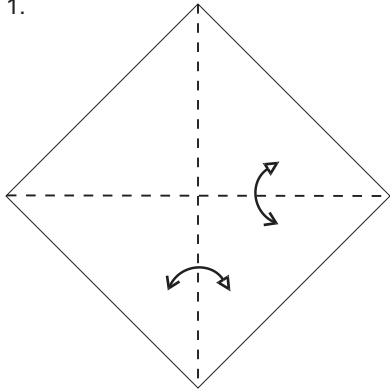


# Heart with Pockets

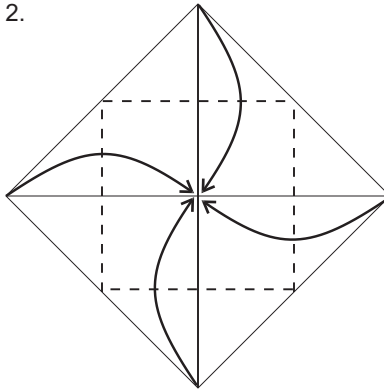
Using a 6 inch (15cm) square will result in a 2 inch (5 cm) tall heart.

1.



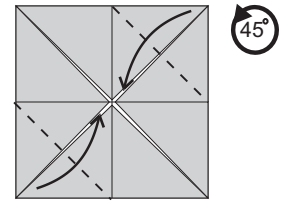
Begin white side up.  
 Valley fold and unfold the diagonals.

2.



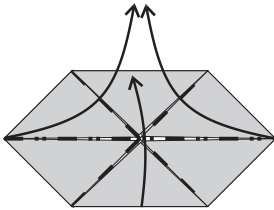
Valley fold all the corners to the center. (Blintz fold)

3.



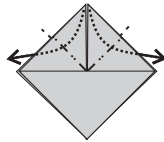
Valley fold the top right and bottom left corners to the center.  
 Rotate the model counter clockwise.

4.



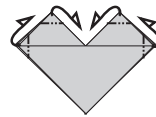
Preliminary like fold.  
 You may want to valley fold and unfold the 'X' and mountain fold and unfold the center creases first.

5.



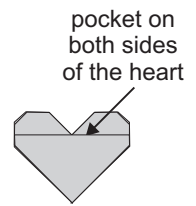
Inside reverse fold down both of the top points.

Mountain fold the top and side points to shape the heart.

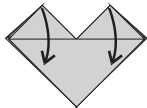

The completed heart!!!

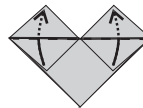
## Extra - Use the following steps to keep the heart from spreading apart.

6b.



Valley fold down the top layers of the top points.

6c.



Valley fold back the points, tucking into the pockets of the back layer points.
